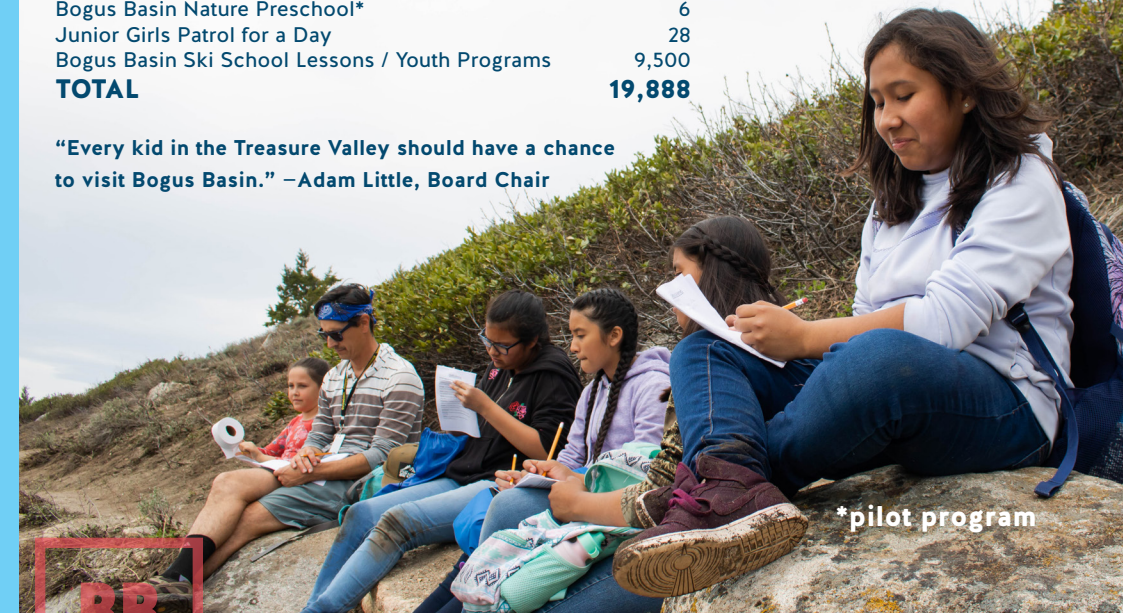

**LOOKING AHEAD**

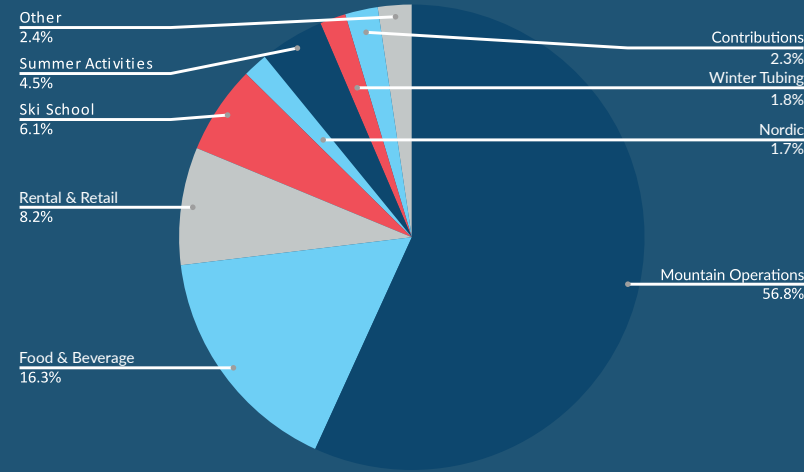
Thank you for being part of the Bogus Basin community.

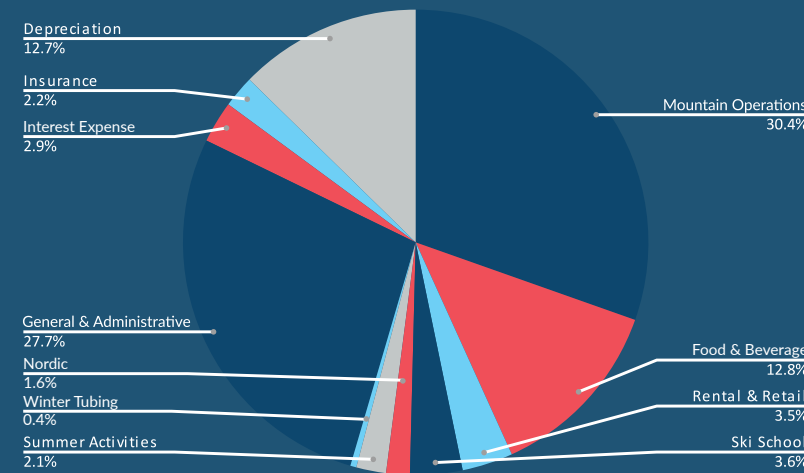
